Erin Harpe & the Delta Swingers • February 10th 8PM

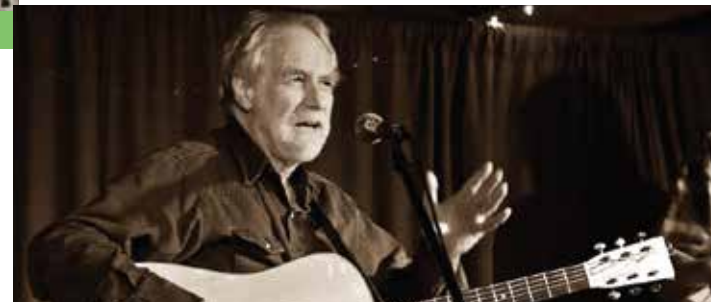
